#### II. The "I Am" Statements of Jesus

John 6:48   "**I Am the Bread of Life**; if anyone eats of this bread, he shall live forever."

John 8:12   "**I Am the Light of the World**; he who follows Me shall not walk in the darkness, but shall have the light of life."

John 10:9   "**I Am the Door**; if anyone enters through Me, he shall be saved."

John 10:11   "**I Am the Good Shepherd**; the good shepherd lays down His life for the sheep."

John 11:25   "**I Am the Resurrection and the Life**; he who believes in Me shall live even if he dies."

John 14:6   "**I Am the Way, the Truth, and the Life**; no one comes to the Father but through Me."

John 15:1, 5 "**I Am the True Vine**." "I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me, and I in him, he bears much fruit; for apart from Me you can do nothing."
